PLASTIC FILM/BAG RECYCLING

We can see the donations to our bins starting to grow! Thank you so much, let's keep it going!

What you can bring: plastic grocery bags; bread bags; bubble wrap; newspaper sleeves; dry cleaning bags; ice bags; plastic shipping envelopes; re-closable food storage bags (Ziplock, etc.); beverage plastic case wrap; salt pellet bags; mulch bags; produce bags; etc.

What you do: just bring your clean plastic film/bags and stuff them into the bins. Remember, it's really important that all the film/plastic be totally clean of food waste or other debris.
